FABRIC MASKS WELCOME AT SCBHS



Orders for standard/disposable masks are on long back-orders, due to both demand and supply chain issues.

While fabric masks are not to be used in the care of COVID-19 patients, according to the CDC, fabric masks are a crisis response option when other supplies have been exhausted. Fabric masks can also be helpful in other areas of patient care as supplies of PPE are depleted.

How can you help? See the details below on how to make and deliver masks for our healthcare staff:

- Use **tightly woven cotton fabric** on both sides.
- Completed masks may be dropped off at our clinic entrance. There will be a tote inside the entrance for mask collection. To arrange a delivery, you may email Holly Rodahl at hrodahl@scbh.org.
- Collected masks will be immediately sent to laundry/processing to be prepared for use.
- Any surplus masks will be distributed to other organizations in need.
